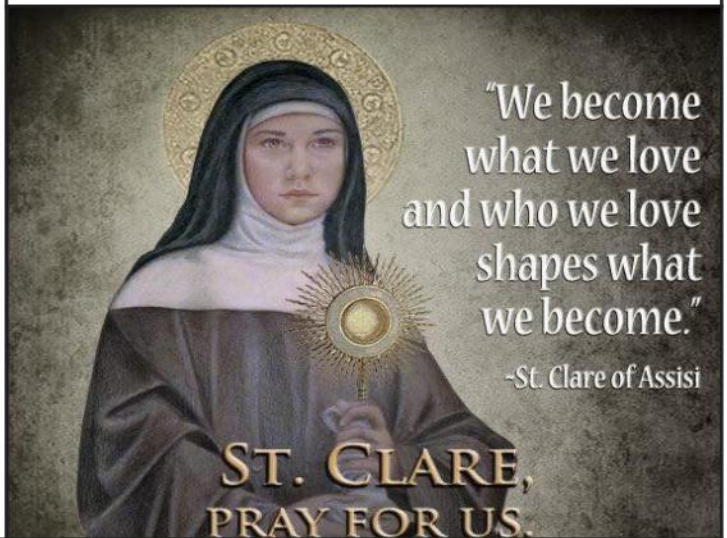

THE BREAD THAT GIVES LIFE FOREVER



The Gospel this Sunday continues with an explanation of the Bread of Life that began last week. Jesus introduced himself as the “bread who came down from heaven.” It was not easy for the Lord’s followers to understand this concept. In their minds, it was clear that their ancestors witnessed the miracle of the bread from heaven, the manna in the desert during Moses’ time, and the Exodus from Egypt. After Jesus’ speech about the Bread from Heaven, people were filled with questions and doubts.

People asked, “Is not this Jesus, whose father and mother we know?” The question is one of disbelief about Jesus’ greatness. They also asked: “How dare he now say ‘I have come down from heaven?’” The word “now” is important here since the people think he has only come from not so far away Nazareth, so how dare he say he came from heaven?

Jesus made it clear in his teachings that the true bread from heaven comes from heaven and gives life. Jesus is the bread and life we can all partake of and benefit from. Manna in the wilderness could not prevent death: “Your ancestors ate manna in the desert, but they died,” Jesus says.

The Bread of Life, Jesus, given in the new dispensation, prevents death. “This is the bread that comes down from heaven for a man to eat and never die,” Jesus says. “If anyone eats this bread, he shall live forever.”

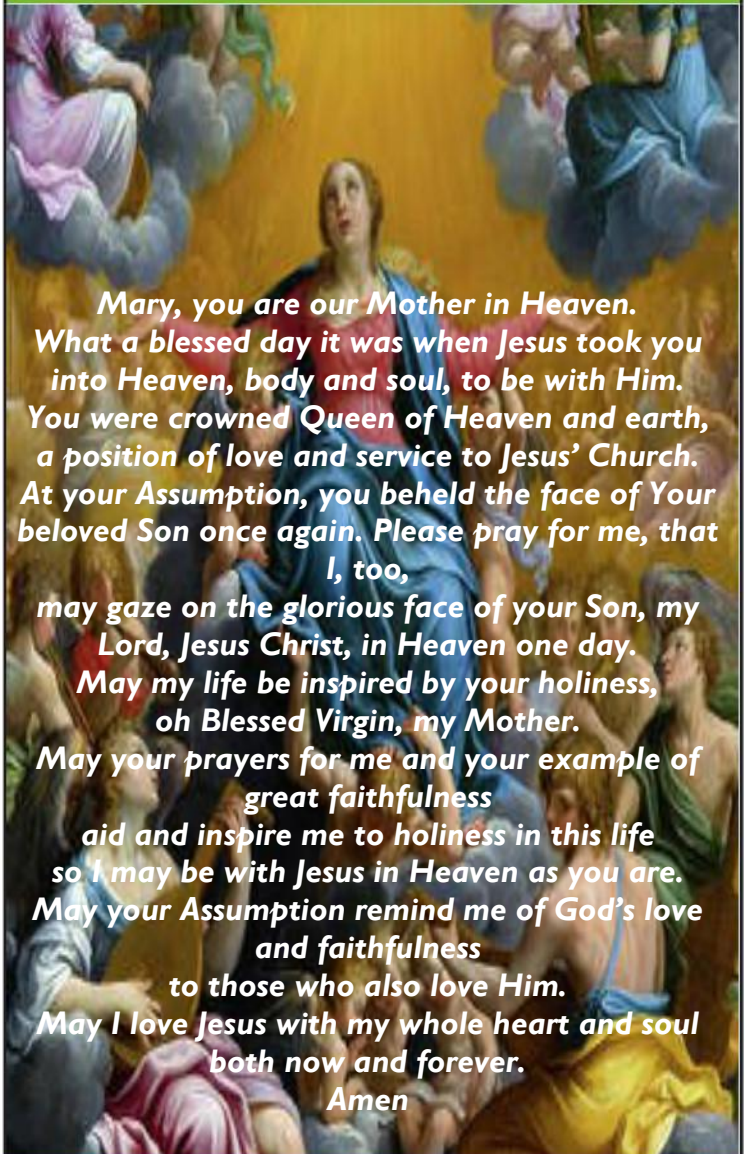
VOTE NO! AMENDMENT 4

aid and inspire me to holiness in this life so I may be with Jesus in Heaven as you are.

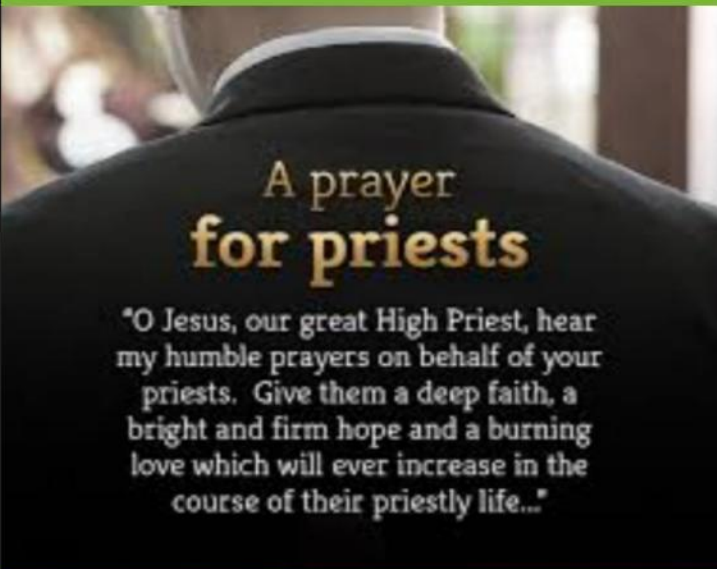

SAINT OF THE WEEK: SAINT CLARE OF ASSISI



One of the more sugary movies about Francis of Assisi pictures Clare as a golden-haired beauty floating through sun-drenched fields, a one-woman counterpart to the new Franciscan Order.

The beginning of her religious life was indeed movie material. Having refused to marry at 15, Clare was moved by Francis' dynamic preaching. He became her lifelong friend and spiritual guide.

At 18, Clare escaped from her father's home one night, was met on the road by friars carrying torches, and in the poor little chapel called the Portiuncula, received a rough woolen habit, exchanged her jeweled belt for a common rope with knots in it, and sacrificed her long tresses to Francis' scissors. He placed her in a Benedictine convent, which her father and uncles immediately stormed in rage. Clare clung to the church's altar, threw aside her veil to show her cropped hair, and remained adamant.

Sixteen days later, her sister Agnes joined her. Others came. According to a Rule Francis gave them as a Second Order, they lived a simple life of great poverty, austerity, and complete seclusion from the world. At age 21, Francis obliged Clare under obedience to accept the office of abbess, one she exercised until her death.

The Poor Ladies went barefoot, slept on the ground, ate no meat, and observed almost complete silence. Later, Clare, like Francis, persuaded her sisters to moderate this rigor: "Our bodies are not made of brass." The greatest emphasis, of course, was on gospel poverty. They possessed no property, even in common, subsisting on daily contributions. When even the pope tried to persuade Clare to mitigate this practice, she showed her characteristic firmness: "I need to be absolved from my sins, but I do not wish to be absolved from the obligation of following Jesus Christ."

Contemporary accounts glow with admiration for Clare's life in the convent of San Damiano in Assisi. She served the sick and washed the feet of the begging nuns. She came from prayer, it was said, with her face so shining it dazzled those about her. She suffered a severe illness for the last 27 years of her life. Her influence was such that popes, cardinals, and bishops often came to consult her—Clare herself never left the walls of San Damiano.

Reflection: The 41 years of Clare's religious life are scenarios of sanctity: an indomitable resolve to lead the simple, literal gospel life as Francis taught her; courageous resistance to the ever-present pressure to dilute the ideal; a passion for poverty and humility; an ardent life of prayer; and a generous concern for her sisters.

ONE-YEAR ANIVERSARY – WORLD YOUTH DAY



A year ago, Pope Francis presided over the closing Mass of WYD in Tejo Park, and in his homily, he asked them a fundamental question: "What do we take with us when we return to our daily lives?" He also encouraged them not to be afraid, encouraging them to think that it was Jesus himself who was looking at them at that moment. "He knows you, he knows the heart of each one of you, he knows the life of each one of you, he knows your joys, he knows your sorrows, your successes, and your failures, he knows your heart," he said. "He reads your hearts, and today He says to you, here in Lisbon, on this World Youth Day: "Do not be afraid." "Take courage, do not be afraid," Francis concluded.

Two of our youth (Itzamal and Xiomara) of our Fire of God Youth Group attended World Youth Day in Lisbon, Portugal. We asked:

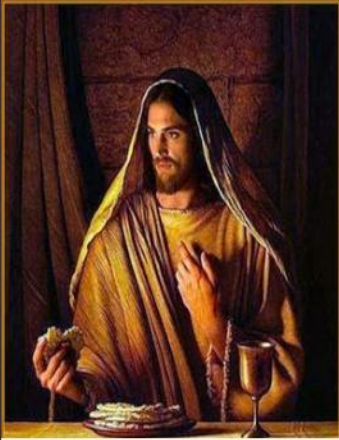
How has World Youth Day changed your life?

One year later...How has World Youth Day affected my life? It's been one year since my pilgrimage to World Youth Day in Lisbon, Portugal. Since then, not only has my faith grown stronger in the Catholic Faith, but my devotion in ministry has skyrocketed. World Youth Day has impacted my heart more than beyond anything that I have ever experienced in my journey. All I want to do is evangelize and spread the good news about Jesus to anyone and everyone. As Pope Francis said during WYD, "Joy isn't for one person; it's to bring to other people." Jesus brings me joy, and why should I keep that joy to myself? Why not spread this joy to others? Since WYD, I would love to join in ministry full time. Not only does it bring me joy, but it brings me so much happiness, and I would love to continue to spread the love of Jesus and help youth grow closer to Christ, not just in my community but everywhere. Since WYD, all I want to do is step out of my comfort zone as I did at World Youth Day. Growing closer to Jesus doesn't always mean we can be comfortable and live repetitive lives. We must be willing to step out of the comfort and try new things but, most importantly, continue to live virtuous and Holy lives. In every Holy Hour I've attended since, I am always reminded that Jesus really is present in the Eucharist, and he is truly with us wherever we go. In every Holy Hour and at every Mass, it is my Jesus, Our Savior Jesus Christ.

I am looking forward to my next journey with Jesus at the next World Youth Day in Seoul, Korea, and to see what plans he has made for me. Let us always remember to "Rise up and go with haste," just as our Blessed Mother Mary did.

En sus mentes, estaba claro que sus antepasados presenciaron el milagro del pan del cielo, el maná en el desierto durante el tiempo de Moisés y el Éxodo de Egipto. Después del discurso de Jesús sobre el Pan del Cielo, la gente se llenó de preguntas y dudas.

La gente se preguntaba: “¿No es éste Jesús, cuyo padre y madre conocemos?” La pregunta es de incredulidad sobre la grandeza de Jesús. También preguntaban: “¿Cómo se atreve ahora a decir: ‘He bajado del cielo?’” La palabra “ahora” es importante aquí, ya que la gente piensa que solo ha venido de la no tan lejana Nazaret, así que ¿cómo se atreve a decir que vino del cielo?

Jesús dejó en claro en sus enseñanzas que el verdadero pan del cielo viene del cielo y da vida. Jesús es el pan y la vida de los que todos podemos participar y beneficiarnos. El maná en el desierto no pudo evitar la muerte: “Vuestros antepasados comieron el maná en el desierto, pero murieron”, dice Jesús.

El Pan de Vida, Jesús, dado en la nueva dispensación, previene la muerte. “Este es el pan que baja del cielo para que el hombre lo coma y nunca muera”, dice Jesús. “Si alguno come de este pan, vivirá para siempre”.

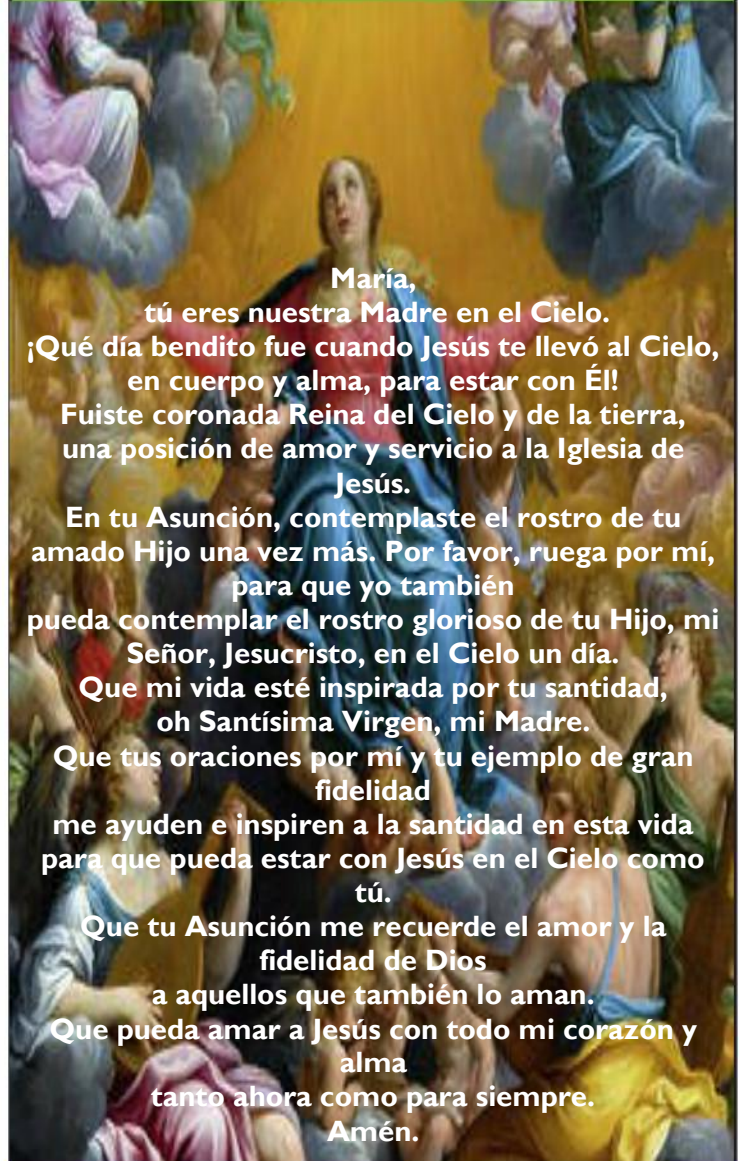
